During the period June 15-17, 2018, we plan to implement additional Common Origination and Disbursement (COD) System functionality for the 2018–19 Award Year. As part of the implementation, Federal Student Aid will move the TEACH Grant Exit counseling module from the National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS®) Student Access website to the [StudentLoans.gov website](http://StudentLoans.gov). Counseling reporting functions will move from the NSLDS Professional Access website to the COD Web Site.
